

- RULES OF MOOT COURT COMMITTEE

SCHEDULE I

[PENALTIES]

1. If a team gets registered with the organizers of any of the moot court competition without due intimation to MCC.	All Academic Exemptions of the respective semester of all the members of the original team and newly added member, if any, shall be cancelled.
2. If any of the members of the original team as certified by MCC to represent university is replaced without prior permission of MCC.	Bar of 1 academic year shall be imposed on the entire team from attending all internal qualifying rounds and hence participating in any moot court competition.
3. If non attendance in Moot Court Competition by any of the members of original team is not duly intimated to MCC before the moot.	Bar of half academic year shall be imposed on the entire team from attending all internal qualifying rounds and hence participating in any moot court competition.
4. If non attendance of Moot Court competition by any of the original members is without any reasonable grounds.	He shall be given due warning and a copy of the same shall be notified [Penalty Notification] on the notice board. Electronic Record of the same has to be maintained on the blog.
5. If non attendance of Moot Court competition by any of the original members is without any reasonable grounds and if such a practice is being repeated the second time	Bar of 1 academic year shall be imposed on the entire team from attending all internal qualifying rounds and hence participating in any moot court competition.
6. If any team leaves the campus for the moot court competition without intimating MCC.	The team shall not be getting any attendance exemption.
7. If any team backs off ¹ once the University gets registered with the organizers at their request.	Bar of 1 academic year shall be imposed on the entire team from attending all internal qualifying rounds and hence participating in any moot court competition.
8. If any student of 10 th Semester is added in the original team and is not the original member of the team.	He shall not get any Academic Exemption for that semester.
9. If any of the members of the interested team are not available on the date of the internal qualifying rounds without reasonable grounds. [Prior intimation in this regard shall be made to the Committee.]	Bar of half academic year shall be imposed on the entire team from attending all internal qualifying rounds and hence participating in any moot court competition.
10. If the selected original team fails to represent University in the Moot Court Competition without any reasonable grounds	Bar of 1 academic year shall be imposed on the entire team from attending all internal qualifying rounds and hence participating in any moot court competition

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Schedule II

[PENALTIES ON MCC MEMBERS]

IRRESPONSIBLE BEHAVIOUR OF MCC MEMBERS IN SPECIAL COMMITTEE	If any of the student members of any of the Special Committees acts irresponsibly, he shall be checked by Faculty member of the Special Committee. The Faculty member of the Committee shall hold power and discretion to bring the acts of any of the student members of Committee before MCC and his acts shall be discussed in the meeting. The accused member shall be given chance to explain his acts. If he is found guilty, for very first act of this kind the accused member shall owe a written apology to the committee specifying non repetition of any such kind of act in future. This letter shall be submitted to the committee.
IF THE MEMBER ² COMMITS ANY OTHER IRREGULARITY IN THE FUTURE	If the same member repeats any other irregularity as and when placed in yet another special committee in future, his act shall be seriously taken note of and Committee shall hold discretion to expel him from the Committee. The Faculty member of the Special Committee shall hold power and discretion to bring the act of any such student member of the Committee before MCC.
IRREGULARITY IN NOTIFICATION OF NEW MOOTS	For all new moots which come on MCC mail, the Convener and Vice Convener shall owe responsibility to notify them on the College notice board and MCC mooting Blog within 48 hours. This responsibility shall continue even during vacations, however the deadline for notification during holidays shall be 96 hours. In case of delay the two members will have to post a letter of apology on the blog specifying the act to be fault of Convener and Vice Convener. Also they shall stand answerable to the committee. Notification regarding internal rounds shall also be notified in the blog.
NON- MAINTAINANCE OF PROPER RECORDS BY MCC Members	If the members entrusted to maintain records fail to present the indexed records every fortnight in the committee meeting they will owe an answer for the same to the Committee. They shall be allowed to enlighten MCC with all difficulties that they faced which prevented them from maintaining records. The Committee may suggest improved ways to maintain records. These members shall get due copy of all notifications and applications being made in relation to all internal qualifying rounds by the Special Committee. If the Special Committee fails to do the same the record keeping member shall bring this to the knowledge of Convener, Vice-Convener and the Committee.
NON- ATTENDANCE OF	If the Committee members do not attend the Committee meeting without valid

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MCC MEMBERS IN THE COMMITTEE MEETING	grounds, the committee shall take note of it. If the practice is repeated twice consecutively, the member shall be warned by the Committee. If this gets repeated thrice the member shall lose voting rights in the committee. Electronic Record of such punishment shall be maintained in the mooting blog.
MISCONDUCT BY ANY MEMBER OR OTHERS DURING ANY MCC MEETING.	Penalty against such members or others shall be affixed by the faculty adviser. Faculty Advisers shall have all discretion in this regard.
